

Uranium Concentrations in Rio Paguate System, Pueblo of Laguna, 2014-2021 (Sources: UNM METALS SRP, Laguna ENRD, Precient Technologies) Findings for Rio Paguate: Site -1: 7.76-40.38 (N=5) Water EXCELLENT for irrigation Sites -6 thru -2: upstream of North Pit (green): low U, low salts (Sites -6 thru -2) JM North Pit: Abrupt worsening of water quality Sites 1,2 ("ford"): 5,600 (N=1) 35.3-711.19 (N=28) inside mine (red) (sites 0-6) U in RP, wetlands behind Mesita Sites 3.4 Dam varies from good to poor. 38.59-132.39 (N=4) depending on flows (sites 7-11) 100->5,600 µg/L No human consumption known: 39.01-300.74 (N=5) wildlife, livestock exposed in mine 30-99 µg/L 36.61-72.06 (N=3) Findings for Rio San Jose: <30 µg/L Sites 9.10.11 . Low in metals (U. As): salinity U range (µg/L) (N) (Paguate increases between New Laguna and Res./Mesita Dam): Mesita 5.46-110.41 (N=14) Limited sampling; aimed at assessing water quality for irrigation OFF MAP: Rio San Jose, New Laguna and Mesita sites: 3.34-7.98 (N=3)
